












Together, we can prevent student quarantines!

<p>If a student has been exposed at school to a person with a probable or confirmed case of COVID, quarantine will be determined as outlined below:</p>		<p>About Masks at GSD: Masks are required at GSD during transition times and any time the student is within 6 feet of another person with no barrier.</p> <p>About close contacts: Close contacts include anyone who spent 15 minutes or more within 6 feet of the positive person during the infectious period.</p> <p>About quarantine processes: Quarantine keeps someone who might have been exposed to the virus away from others. Individuals who have symptoms during their quarantine should immediately isolate and get tested.</p> <p>About fully vaccinated: Fully vaccinated means it has been 2 weeks after final dose of vaccine was received.</p> <p>About a probable case: A probable case means not tested but exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID.</p> <p>About home exposure: An unvaccinated individual identified as a close contact to a confirmed or probable case at home (outside of the school setting) is required to quarantine, due to regular unmasked exposure.</p>
<p>IF  /6 ft AND Fully Vaccinated Masked or 6+ feet distanced</p>	<p>  NO QUARANTINE</p>	
<p>IF  +  /6 ft BUT Not Fully Vaccinated Masked or 6+ feet distanced</p>	<p>  NO QUARANTINE</p>	
<p>IF  +  /<6 ft AND Not Fully Vaccinated Not Masked or 6 + feet distanced</p>	<p>  QUARANTINE</p>	
<p>NOTE: While many cases are the result of community transmission that occurred away from school, some cases may be the result of close contact in a school setting. Quarantine may be required if a cluster of related cases occur in a classroom or group setting.</p>
