Donation

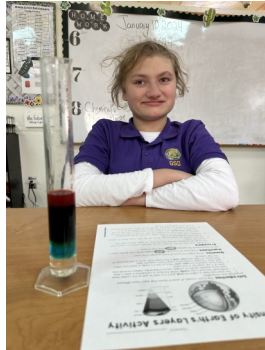

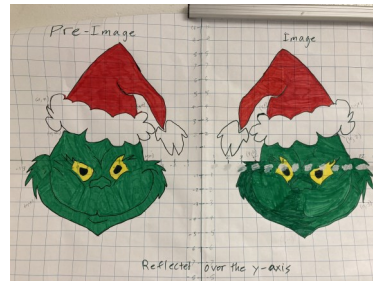
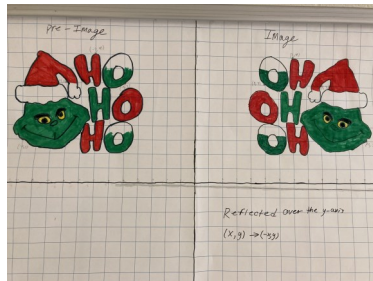
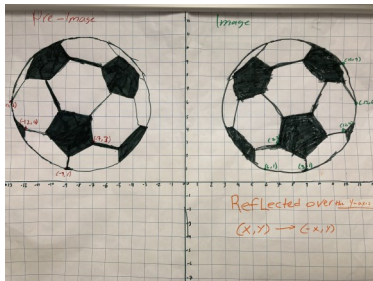


Earth's Layers
