<p>Description of Duties: Knowledge of, and the ability to assist in instructing, reading, writing, and mathematics; or knowledge of, the ability to assist in instructing, reading readiness, writing readiness and mathematics readiness, as appropriate. Assists teacher with providing a comprehensive educational program to meet the needs of hearing impaired students. Responsibilities include preparing instructional materials; maintaining order and cleanliness in an educational environment; assisting students with physical needs; monitoring student behavior; and observing and reporting student progress. Assists students with instructional needs individually and in small groups and tutoring student in core subject areas. Bus monitor on the Macon Charter bus on a rotating basis (once or twice) each month.</p>			
<p>Minimum Qualifications: Must hold/be eligible for Paraprofessional certification from the Georgia Professional Standards Commission. Demonstrate, through a formal academic assessment, the ability to instruct in reading, writing, and mathematics. Ability to ride long distances on a charter bus. Must be willing to learn American Sign Language (ASL) proficiency at the "Intermediate" level or higher as measured by the Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI), ASL Proficiency Interview (ASLPI), or as assessed by qualified GSD staff.</p>			
<p>Preferred Qualifications: Preference will be given to applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum qualifications, possess one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two years of study at an Institution of Higher Learning (60 semester hrs. or 90 quarter hrs. regional accredited) or obtained an Associate's (or higher Degree) • Two years of successful experience as a paraprofessional • Possess American Sign Language (ASL) proficiency at the "Intermediate Plus" level or higher as measured by the Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI), ASL Proficiency Interview (ASLPI), or as assessed by qualified GSD staff.
